Metropolitan Officials Association Scholarship Criteria

1. Student must have at least a “C” average and submit a copy of transcripts with the application.(January, 2020)
2. Student must be a graduating senior or have GED equivalent for the year of application.
3. Student must be an active member of a team(s).
4. Student must be an active participant in a Community/Public Service Organization.
5. Student must submit a fully completed application signed and all questions answered.
6. Student should submit at the time of application at least a one-page essay indicating his/her goals for higher education.
7. Student must be able to satisfy an interview by Scholarship Committee personnel.
8. Student should present at the time of application two (2) letters of recommendation: (family members excluded). Letters should come from a church leader at the church of which you are a member, representative of the community or public service organization of which you are an active participant, or a school administrator/faculty member/coach, of the school that you are presently attending.
